6. Finance Report

- League fees still \$725 this year despite field fees going up last year.
- Net income \$1600 last year.
- We keep our fees low. Part of this is by self-umpiring.
- Financial Report will be posted to the web site.

7. Fields Report

- We have 12 fields
 - Braefoot Park Mon
 - Uplands
 - Cedar Hill Middle School
 - Cedar Hill Rec Centre the left field has been extended. They are also working on drainage. Will need a special rule for this field...had one when we used to use this field. They have also committed to maintain the infield better (keep it watered).

- We do not have Braefoot School
- No Windsor Park they are doing reno's we will get it back next year.

Season Dates:

- Season Starts April 20
- Ice Breaker @ Lansdowne May 9 this year.
- Year End Tournament Aug. 7-9
 - August 7 (Lansdowne, Cedar Hill & Uplands)
 - o Aug. 8, 9 all at Lansdowne.
- Tony always reminds the schools about our dates don't turn on the sprinklers etc. Let him know if any problems.
- MAPS will be posted on the web site, along with permits for use.

8. Rules Report - Code of Conduct

- New Teams: you must provide:
 - BASES 3 of which are carpets, also a safety base for 1st base. Measurements are in the rules.
 - BALLS must be super gold or super grey dot (limited flight). We do this so we
 don't have to regulate bats. Colour does not matter. The home team supplies a
 new ball. Yellow is a good colour early in the season.
 - CONES you need 6-8 of them to mark the boundaries, commitment marker between 3rd & home, and outfield.

Code of Conduct:

- This mirrors the Code that SPN uses.
- There are a few different issues the code is intended to address (e.g. one team did not show up for the tournament, there were some violent behaviour in the tourney, schools have strict rules & we need to ensure teams are aware of them so we don't risk losing fields).
- Suspensions or fines determined by the Executive.
- Drinking after the game not at the fields.
- Question regarding what level of fines for infractions. There are many extenuating circumstances so it we are hesitant to set amounts ahead of time.
- Motion raised & withdrawn to set amounts for fines at outset of the year. The
 executive will discuss any circumstances as & when required & set an amount.

Rules:

- All team encouraged to read the rules over several times, especially new teams.
- o Feedback invited on the fields, particularly Cedar Hill Rec Centre.
- Outfielders (4 of them) cannot advance beyond an arc on the field.
- Overthrows runners are granted 2 bases from where you started automatically.
- If the ball is caught in-field & carried out runners are granted 1 base from where they started.
- Pitching rule is that if the pitcher throws 10 balls in a row you must replace the pitcher. It is very frustrating otherwise and slows the game down considerably.
- o If a pitch does not have proper arc (6-12 feet) it is a No Pitch / Dead Ball.

9. Volunteer positions

- **a. Garbage at tourneys –** Average Joe's volunteered for both tournaments.
- **b. Toilets** 2-Baggers volunteered.
